JESUS IN THE GARDEN

THIS WEEK'S GOSPEL

Mark 14:32-41

They went to a place called Gethsemane; and he said to his disciples, 'Sit here while I pray.' 33He took with him Peter and James and John, and began to be distressed and agitated. ³⁴And he said to them, 'I am deeply grieved, even to death; remain here, and keep awake.' 35And going a little farther, he threw himself on the ground and prayed that, if it were possible, the hour might pass from him. ³⁶He said, 'Abba, Father, for you all things are possible; remove this cup from me; yet, not what I want, but what you want.' 37He came and found them sleeping; and he said to Peter, 'Simon, are you asleep? Could you not keep awake one hour?³⁸Keep awake and pray that you may not come into the time of trial; the spirit indeed is willing, but the flesh is weak.' 39 And again he went away and prayed, saying the same words. ⁴⁰And once more he came and found them sleeping, for their eyes were very heavy; and they did not know what to say to him. 41He came a third time and said to them, 'Are you still sleeping and taking your rest? Enough! The hour has come; the Son of Man is betrayed into the hands of sinners.

YOUTH HOMILY by Shelby Lackey

In this short story, Jesus goes to pray and he asks his disciples to stay on watch while he does. Each time he returns they are asleep. He does this three times. Each time he does this he feels more alone as he was depending on his disciples. Jesus is also worried about what God is asking of him. He needs support and he struggles with whether or not his disciples are willing to follow him, stay with him and support him through this time.

Has this ever happened to you? I have had someone in my life that has continuously let me down. It's hard to understand why he does it and hard to not think it's my fault. When I pray about it I become distressed and deeply grieved. I think I feel a little bit of what Jesus felt. I know God is there but just like Jesus, it's difficult to trust that it is all going to be ok. My mom tells me that God gives us three answers "yes", "no", and "wait". It is hard to wait. Waiting doesn't mean you do nothing though; it means you pray for your answer and trust that you will get one in time. Then don't be discouraged if you don't get the answer you're looking for, it just means something else is waiting for you.

Despite Jesus' discouragement in this passage, he continues to pray throughout it and gets reminded that we live by God's will, not our own. This is good news for all of us. We aren't alone in the most difficult moments. God's will is always working to bring new life to us. I continue to pray for that new life and I challenge you to pray for new life when you are distressed.
