Today's feast day celebrates the

Archangels Michael, Gabriel and Raphael.

Archangels (Jude 9; 1 Thes 4:16) are chief of the nine choirs of angels.

St. Michael Archangel is Prince of the Seraphim (the highest choir of angels), having a unique role as God's messenger of salvation (Tb 12:6, 15; Jn 5:4; Rv 12:7-9)

Archangel Michael - Since the time of the Apostles, Archangel Michael has been invoked as patron and protector by the Church as the leader of the forces of heaven in their triumph over Satan and his followers.

Archangel Gabriel first appeared in the Old Testament in the prophesies of Daniel, announcing the prophecy of 70 weeks (Dn 9:21-27). He appeared to Zechariah to announce the birth of St. John the Baptist (Lk 1:11) and he Announced to Mary that she would be the mother of our Lord and Saviour. (Lk 1:26)

Archangel Raphael first appeared in the book of Tobit (Tobias)Tb 3:25, 5:5-28, 6-12).
