Our Mission Trip was to Northwest Arkansas & we partnered with three feeding ministries, Habitat for Humanity and Children & Family Advocacy Center.

Our projects included:

- Preparing a freezer full of meals for single moms living in The Lodge, which is a safe place as they rebuild their lives.
- Working with the Peace Lutheran Church food pantry doing restocking and bringing boxes of food to the cars of families experiencing food insecurity.
- Preparing and serving a meal with Feast of Grace feeding ministry.
- Working with the Christ the King Lutheran Church food pantry doing restocking and bringing boxes of food to the cars of families experiencing food insecurity.
- Working on three separate Habitat for Humanity houses in which several days they got to work alongside the home owners.
- Restoring (demo and repairs) the House of Faith, which is a transitional living home for single mom families working to gain independence.
