Stewardship Corner

With Joy and Thanksgiving...Our Possessions

“Merciful Father, we offer with joy and thanksgiving what you have first given us – our selves, our time, and our possessions, signs of your gracious love. Receive them for the sake of him who offered himself for us, Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen.”

Our Stewardship Committee continues to dive into what it means to “Be a GOOD Steward” by putting our focus for this third season of stewardship into how we can best offer with joy and thanksgiving, our selves, our time and our **possessions**. To offer our **possessions** in a faith context means recognizing God as the owner of all things. (Maybe all we have is not really OUR possessions, we are merely the stewards.) We are called to practice stewardship by using all resources for His purposes, including supporting the church, sharing talents and adopting a lifestyle of gratitude rather than selfishness.

Consider that giving with joy and thanksgiving means voluntarily sharing possessions out of gratitude for God’s blessings, rather than duty or obligation. Giving can be an expression of joy in being able to share. It can break the hold of material possessions on our hearts, offering freedom from greed and anxiety rather than clinging to temporary earthly goods.

We frequently hear the phrase “sharing is caring”. A joyful outpouring can transform possessions from items that “grip us” into tools that bring joy to others and honor to God.

We would enjoy hearing how YOU offer your possessions to honor our God.

Via de Cristo in April

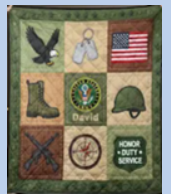
