The Church Mouse



Good Morning! I am writing a couple days early today. It is Sunday and the church is quiet. The campus is covered in white and it makes everything seem even quieter. Even the cats aren't prowling around, which is a great bonus of winter weather! I miss my friends and laying under the organ feeling the vibration of the music, but momma says that the church is not the building, but the people. God is with us wherever we are! Our mouse family gathered in the quiet sanctuary and watched the service on line. If you close your eyes you can feel God and your friends. We wore our jammies and then went to get the hot cocoa that Janelle left out in the kitchen for us. Then it was time to play in the snow, while dad made sure all the faucets were dripping. I put the stopper in the sink, hoping those drips might turn into an indoor ice rink, but no luck so far.

I love how supportive everyone is of my friend and I training for our mouse-athon! We didn't place last year, but had fun and momma said the win was having fun and keeping our bodies moving! We appreciate all of you bringing so much food for NEED. The cans and boxes make the best obstacle training course. There were also toys this year which adds sounds to the course. If you step wrong some of the toys beep and make noises. It was a great added component to our training! Crossing our fingers for our second mouse-athon. Momma said all of the food and toys were at church because Calvary families were helping other people who have rumby tummies and needed a little help with Christmas presents for their kiddos.

My whole life Calvary has invited guests during the coldest and hottest months of the summer! The math of how many that is, is a little to big for me still, but that is a lot of people who have found refuge and felt God's love here. Lots of the volunteers are the same, with some new ones too! Margaret and Kay still let me have the job of bouncing on the air mattresses to make sure they are full enough. The food is as yummy and plentiful as when I was a baby mouse.
