We are off to a great start for 2026 in Outreach. Our New Member Luncheon in January welcomed 13 families into our Congregation. We have two co-committee members representing the Outreach Committee. One of the definitions of the word outreach is “extending services, information, or help to people, by going to them rather than waiting for them to come to you”. 


